Rules of the competition

**1. Preliminary Competition for Screening**

The competition shall be held to select 5 participants (3 from UG classes and 2 from PG classes) from each of the three streams of Arts, Science and Commerce.

**2. Final Competition**

The final competition will be held among the 15 participants selected from the three streams in the preliminary competition.

**3. Duration**

Each participant will be given 3+1 minutes time to speak both in the preliminary and final competitions.

**4. Number of Judges**

Three judges shall be required to conduct the competition. The Vice-Chancellor shall select the judges for the Final round competition.

**5 Topic of the Debate**


The topic of the debate shall be announced one hour before the commencement of the debate.


b. If more than one participant qualifies for the same position then the amount of the cash prize meant for that position shall be divided among the winners.
