Prof. Bijoy Mohan Misra is at present working in the Faculty of Arts and Sciences of Harvard University, Cambridge, USA. Born in Cuttack and educated at Ravenshaw, Prof. Misra studied Aviation and Meteorology in Pune and became the first Indian scientist to win the World Meteorological Organization Award for the Young Scientists. He afterwards became a research scientist at MIT and Harvard University and taught at both the institutions. He has immensely contributed to the fields of sky mapping, object detection and space missions winning national and international citations, awards and recognitions. Besides space sciences, his research interests involve brain science, linguistics and the knowledge aspects of the Indian cultural history. Currently he leads Harvard University's India Discovery Center in USA to help create educational materials for the youth around the world.
