If a candidate fails to report for counselling / admission as per the schedule, he / she shall forfeit all claims for admission. If any discrepancy is found in the documents during verification, his/her candidature is liable to forfeiture or his/her rank may stand altered.

**Documents to be produced at the time of admission:**

The following certificates and documents in original and self-attested photocopies of

1. Aadhar Card (mandatory)
2. Print out of the application form (which was submitted online by the candidate) with a recent passport size photograph of the candidate affixed on it
3. Certificate of High School Examination or equivalent in support of age
4. Mark Sheet and Certificate of Higher Secondary Examination or equivalent
5. School or College Leaving Certificate, Migration Certificate (if any). However, Students who have taken admission in other college / University need to produce the CLC/ Migration / Conduct within 5 days from the day of counselling, only if the admission is confirmed.
6. Certificate(s) in support of claim for Reservation, Weightage and Domicile, if any.

7. For Ex-Service Men (ESM): The Discharge Certificate with details of family members should, signed by competent authority, shall be furnished in the original.
8. For Serving Defence Personnel (SDP): Candidate should furnish a certificate from the Commanding Officer of the unit giving proof of current service.
9. Blood Group Certificate
10. Four recent stamp size photographs
11. All the admitted students are required to fill up the online anti-ragging undertaking form at [www.antiragging.in](http://www.antiragging.in) or [www.amammovement.org](http://www.amammovement.org) positively and submit a copy as proof of the same.

- (i) The photocopies of all documents should be self-attested by the candidate.
- (ii) Submission of incorrect information may lead to cancellation of admission.
